Historical Committee Meeting Minutes – June 30, 2007.

John Williams started the meeting at 12 noon. He shared several maps and aerial photographs that were copied from the Historical Society. One was dated as far back as 1936. There were also brochures and copies of post cards. These items will be available at the next Advisory Council meeting.

Items of Note:

In the 1936 aerial map, Builders Supply, Ramon Park Trailer Park and a Texaco Station are within the WSNO boundaries. The airport was located just north of WSNO on the corner of Alejo and Caballeros.

A 1940 tract map shows, Ajo, Encilia, Santa Rosa, Abronia, Roca being an approved tract, the Palo Verde tract at the southern curve of Palm Canyon (currently TRENNO), the Ramon Park Trailer Park and possibly the Primrose/Amapola area being the only approved tracts in Section 23.

In the 1956 aerial map, there is a park where the Bank of America is currently located.

Committee Objectives:

Committee Members have decided to document all housing in the neighborhood. Items of note will include year built and original owner. Each member will begin documenting individual properties within a tract. Max and Bill will take the Vista Santa Rosa Tract, John will take the Warm Sands Tract and Robert will take the Indian Trail Tract.
