- **Tahquitz Creek Parkway** - We briefly discussed the wash project getting a total of \$60,000 recently. \$25,000 from the city of Palm Springs, \$25,000 from a developer and \$10,000 from the county of Riverside.
- **Neighborhood Watch Signs** – 20 signs are on order. The group discussed placement of 20 signs. Bill will present the map to the Advisory Council for approval. All felt it was important to have a sign on each street on WSNO's northern boundary.* Ramon Park will receive 2 signs.
- **Current Crime** – We discussed the car break in on Palo Fierro.
- **Mid-night walk** – We discussed the last walk and the dark parking lots on Parocela. We reported that these lots were bright the week after our walk. Next walk will be July 27th.
- **Block Captains** – We discussed the need to have more participation from other streets. Bill will take the west side and Frank will take the east side of Warm Sands Drive and encourage more participation. Our goal would be to have a Block Captain or Leader from each block.
